The CarbonNet Project is investigating the potential for establishing a world class, large scale, multi-user carbon capture and storage network in Victoria's Gippsland region, transporting the CO_2 via pipeline and injecting it into deep offshore underground storage. An appraisal well is planned to test the suitability of the Pelican geological structure for carbon storage for the CarbonNet Project. The crest of the Pelican structure is located only 3km from the south east Victorian coast in a water depth of 20m. A schedule (assurance) and cost (independent assessment) were carried out to drill and test an offshore appraisal well in the Gippsland basin region.
