Thevenard Island (TVI) is a C class nature reserve located approximately 25 km off the coast from Onslow in the North West of Western Australia. Since 1989 it has been the site of an oil and gas production facility, and is currently operated by Chevron Australia.

In considering its options for the retirement of the TVI facilities, Chevron engaged the services of Linch-pin prior to the first framing session in Phase 1 of the Chevron Project Development and Execution Process (CPDEP). The TVI facilities include:

- Onshore plant.
- 9-off offshore platforms.
- Onshore and offshore wells.
- Onshore and offshore pipelines.

Linch-pin provided the core technical, cost and schedule support during Phases 1 and 2 and has continued to support Chevron during Phase 3 with engineering, quantity surveying, onshore and offshore construction management expertise.
