

The Legendre field is located 100km North West of Dampier off the North-West shelf of Western Australia. It is owned in Joint Venture by Apache Energy Limited (77.44%) and Santos (32.56%) and operated by Apache Energy Limited (AEL).

The production facilities are based around a small, centrally located wellhead, process and accommodation platform, the Ocean Legend, which is a Mobile Offshore Production Unit (MOPU). Produced fluids are processed on the MOPU with the stabilised crude oil being exported via a short flexible pipeline to a Floating Storage and Offloading (FSO) vessel, the Karratha Spirit. Surplus produced gas is reinjected into a gas injection well at the MOPU. The FSO is soft moored to a Catenary Anchor Leg Mooring (CALM) buoy.

Linch-pin was invited to assist Apache with the management of the concept select, define and execution stages of the decommissioning and abandonment of the Legendre Field with scope covering:

- Stakeholder Analysis
- Consents and Approvals Plan
- Decommissioning Plan
- Project Master Schedule
- Budget Estimates
- Risk Assessments
- Execution plan and sub plans
- Day to day management of the select, define and execute processes
- Preparation of supplier work scopes
- Supervision of contractors (on and offshore)
- Preparation of safety cases
- Interfacing with operations and corporate functions
